## 2012 Trainee Travel Award Application

ICPI has launched a program to support trainee participation in scientific meetings organized by its sponsoring and associate member societies. A limited number of ICPI Trainee Travel Awards are available in 2012. There are 2 types of Travel Awards:

- 1) **Trainee Travel Award:** \$500.00 for trainees who do not submit an abstract
- 2) **Trainee Travel Award with Abstract:** \$750.00 for trainees who are an author/co-author on an accepted abstract at the meeting they are attending.

The award is a stipend intended to offset the travel costs for attending one of ICPI's member societies' meetings. Awardees must currently be a trainee (medical student, graduate student, resident, fellow) member of one of the member societies:

To apply for this award, candidates must send the following documents to the ICPI administrative office at least 30 days prior to the meeting applied for:

1. Completed ICPI Trainee Travel Award Application
2. Cover letter, not to exceed 150 words, indicating which meeting the applicant will use the award to attend and describing the applicant's interests in participating in the designated meeting
3. Letter of recommendation from the applicant's supervisor or training director which attests to the candidate's pathologist-in training status and potential
4. Proof of membership in the society for the meeting attended
5. Copy of abstract (if submitting for the Travel Award with Abstract)

#### Eligible candidates will:

- Be a trainee member of one of ICPI's sponsoring or associate member societies
- Apply the travel award to a meeting sponsored by one of ICPI's member societies
- Please note that recipients of the 2010 & 2011 ICPI Trainee Travel Award are ineligible in 2012.

The Intersociety Council for Pathology Information will select awardees based upon availability of funds, cover letter, abstract (if submitting), and letter of recommendation from the supervisor or training director.

**Awardees will receive the stipend after the meeting upon providing the following:**

- proof of attendance at the meeting (receipt or copy of meeting badge)
- personal statement of how the award was beneficial, for posting on the ICPI website
- digital photograph of the recipient, for posting on the ICPI website
- completed IRS Form W-9 (for US citizens and residents)
