## *Cytopathology Fellowship*

**Description:** The Department of Pathology at the University of Florida Health Science Center/Jacksonville Division offers two one-year cytopathology fellowship positions with emphasis on diagnostic cytology. The fellows evaluate and participate in the sign-out of all abnormal gynecologic preparations, as well as all non-gynecologic preparations. Training is provided in the performance, preparation and evaluation of fine needle aspiration biopsies and ductal lavage. Immunocytochemistry, electron microscopy, flow cytometry, image analysis and automated cytology are utilized for analysis of cytologic material. The fellow participates in training junior residents. Research activity is encouraged. Resources include all technical procedures performed in the Cytopathology Laboratory as well as the Tumor Analysis Laboratory.
